Maine DEP used a variety of approaches and methods to provide **6,725** total assists in 2007. The following chart provides a breakdown of the major assistance categories. This does not include web site visits for the office which total over **117, 670** potential recipients of program and regulatory information.

1. Governor's Carbon Challenge Program
 - Signed up 80 participants including over 130 facilities
 - Eliminated over 96,000 metric tonnes of carbon
2. Assisted facilities through multi-media outreach including audits and EMS facilitation
3. Policy analysis of opportunities to innovate
4. Strengthening innovation partnering
5. Working one-on-one utilizing pollution prevention (P2) concepts with:
 - Individuals
 - Facilities
 - Environmental groups
