

## **Small Business Stationary Source Compliance Advisory Panel**

### **Regulatory Review Committee Charge**

**Adopted February 22, 2001**

- 1) On a trial basis, review, and as appropriate, develop comments on proposed federal, state, and local air quality regulations that may require compliance from small businesses. Provide draft comments to the Panel listing recommendations to assist small businesses in complying with the final air quality regulation without reducing the level of proposed air quality benefit. Compliance assistance can be accomplished by commenting on the following areas:
  - a) Suggesting alternate language that would make the requirements of the regulation easier to understand,
  - b) Minimizing the cost of meeting the proposed level of air quality benefit by suggesting:
    - Alternate methods of compliance
    - Alternate methods of monitoring
    - Alternate record keeping requirements
    - Alternate reporting requirements.
  - c) Identifying types of assistance needed to bring small businesses into compliance
- 2) Serve as a sounding board for the Division for Air Quality (DAQ) and the Jefferson County Air Pollution Control District (JCAPCD) in the informal development of regulations affecting small businesses.
- 3) Implement a notification system to alert small businesses to proposed air quality regulations that might affect their companies.
