**Spray-coating for Motor Vehicles and Mobile Equipment
Petition for Exemption**

40 CFR Part 63.11169 – 63.11180, Subpart HHHHHH

Only apply if you DO NOT use coatings containing chromium (Cr), lead (Pb), manganese (Mn), nickel (Ni) or cadmium (Cd).

Owners or operators of businesses that paint motor vehicles or mobile equipment may ask the N.C. Division of Air Quality and the US Environmental Protection Agency for an exemption from this rule if they can show that they **do not spray apply** any coatings that as mixed contain any of the following Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP).

- **chromium** (Cr)
- **manganese** (Mn)
- **nickel** (Ni)
- **cadmium** (Cd)
- **lead** (Pb)

To apply for the exemption you must provide the following information.
