Area Source ID Project

- 12 states have responded
- Drop Dead Submittal Date established -- March 15
- If not going to respond, please send email to Richard
- 12 states who have responded have already equaled the total affected sources compared to EPA's original numbers
- Keith Barnett was hoping to already match up the rule writers to states

Autobody Project

- Kim Teal wants the workgroup to take a look at the Misc. Plastics rule to see if the reporting and recordkeeping rules would work for the autobody sector
- This workgroup is participating in a formal process and conference call proceedings are part of the official docket
- ERG is a contractor for EPA on this project. SBAPs have concerns about the knowledge level of ERG. Felt that "playing catch up" by ERG may waste time when there are SBAPs that are very familiar with this sector
- Spray guns as type of control technology
- PTE Guidance for Autobody is a good resource to use for this rule development (Rick Carleski)

- EPA proposing to exempt 5/6 categories
- Be sure to check with your state to make sure they are not sending out call for applications

TBAC Delisting

- Concerns over reporting burdens
- Concern over permitting due to delisted substances
- Begins with 2005 reporting
- TBAC found in industrial coatings, adhesives, solvents, certain inks.
- EPA contact is Terry Keating (SP)
- States would like some kind of Guidance from EPA
- Angela said she would look into it if we could get her some questions.
- Mike is going to write up a summary Richard will forward to Angela.
- What about future delistings?
- How is this going to be handled on MSDS?

Residual Risk-DRY Cleaner

- Issues of Concern
 - Phase out transfer machines
 - Co-located facilities

Major HAP Sources w/ NO MACT

- Rhonda Thompson from SC has been putting together a list of source categories emitting toxics that do not have a major source MACT
- Basically, these are new source categories with no MACTS and the possibility of proposing new MACTS for these source categories

STAPPA Permitting Calls

- Renee still volunteers to sit in on these calls for the group.

Ready Mix Concrete (Tony)

- Stack testing complete for new AP-42 factors.
 - Truck Mix plants seem to have lower PM emission factors
 - Central mix plants have higher
 - Concerns over arsenic and mercury in flyash and cement
 - Seem to be stronger correlation with wind speed and moisture content
 - TRI Reporting
 - Almost all of these facilities should be doing TRI reports
