**Minutes:**

Renee confirmed with group whether July 22<sup>nd</sup> date is OK for next call.

Renee summarized events and issues from the National Conference, then asked for comments/questions from the group.

- GDF – issues with “submerged fill” definition
  - how to explain in plain language
  - bottom fill, drop fill, drop tube, others?
- States putting information into plain language on paint rule?
  - MO, SC, IL, WI have examples, and others
  - suggestion to separate by operations
  - TN having problems b/c regulators concerned about misinterpretation
    - could share materials with Sharon and she’ll ask rule writer to review
- On paint rule tools still needed – review Renee’s presentation and notes from National Conference and send any other ideas
- Use Sharon’s Implementation Tool table to link to state tools via the New Rule Page
- Did have some interest from Regional Air Toxics contacts at Conference – how is interaction in regions?
  - Region 2 – not much
  - Region 1 – regular contact with Judy
  - Region 3 and 5 – coordinating conference calls
- New bin rules
  - not affected if no materials with metal HAPs
  - OMB made them take out extra VOC requirements
  - Kim will share fact sheet/article with group (details?)
  - check out Renee’s presentation from National Conference - with basic content from signed rules
- GDF rule – out of rule if have state RACT?
  - Jim – NY not same because of testing/monitoring requirement in NESHAP
  - Rick – same issue
  - operating practices (in RACT?) includes monitoring, so maybe that will help
