

**Minutes**  
**Technical Subcommittee Call**  
**November 27, 2007**

1. SBA Reform Initiative

The following are regulations we came up with today:

- Petroleum Dry Cleaner NSPS – because current technology does not allow the same testing as used for older technology.
- Once In Always In policy (not sure if we can list this because it's not a rule)
- TRI threshold of 100 pounds lead – too many affected at this level, and doesn't really provide environmental benefit
- Paint Stripping/Miscellaneous Surface Coating – only because we know there will still be aspects that need changing, and will be out at least 15 days prior to SBA deadline

(Keith provided a brief update on OIAI – based on what he's heard, it's currently on the back burner and there's no sign that it will be picked up soon.)

2. National Conference Topics

The following ideas were provided to Stacey to take to the planning committee next week:

- information on the final rules from December 15<sup>th</sup> bin, the June 15<sup>th</sup> 2008 bin, and changes to the dry cleaner rule (which are expected to be final by the end of the year – exact changes uncertain)
- brainstorming session on compliance assistance tools the SBEAPs could use for the paint stripping/ misc. coating rule (to be facilitated) – it might be a good idea to let this stretch across 2 session time slots to really flesh out the ideas in person
- greenhouse gases and/or climate change – basics on the issues as well as brief info on what different states are doing with regulations (Terry is doing doctoral research on the issue, and could be persuaded to be a speaker on this... Thanks for the visual Terry!)
