Our Compliance Focus

- We work with nonmajor facilities
- Our program contract limits us
- “Cap out” to avoid Title V and NESHAP
- Comply with NY Toxics rule
- Get a permit or registration

A Cap That Fits

- Good emissions inventory
- Plan for future growth
- Seasonal production peaks
- Cap at 50%, no reporting or public notice
- Synthetic minor permit, records/reporting

The Right Tools

- Good emission factors
- Computer spreadsheet for recordkeeping
- ACMA and Minnesota work
- NY SBAP modified Minn spreadsheet
- Using Minnesota model for our program

True Stories

- Pool and Spa Company
- Permitted at 50%, (“capped by rule”)
- Business took off
- Need synthetic minor permit for 10 ton cap
