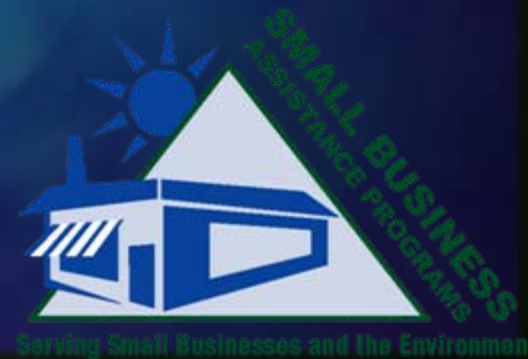

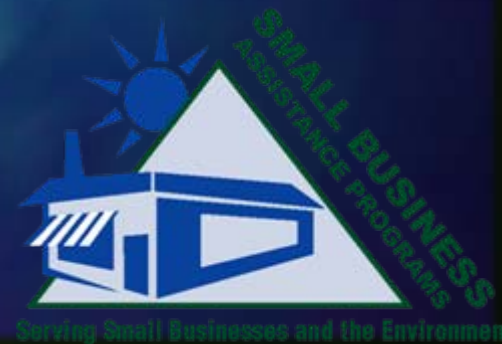
The DSCA Story
